

Crocheted Badge Necklace

Items Needed

- 35 Yards Worsted Weight Yarn*
- Size G (4mm) Crochet Hook
- Scissors
- Yarn Needle

Stitch Definitions

- ch = chain
- sc = single crochet

All stitches use the US definition.

Gauge

- 14 stitches over 4 inches *



Instructions

Chain 126

Row One: Starting in the second chain from the hook, sc to the end of the row. (125 stitches)

Row Two: Ch 1 and turn. Sc 61 stitches, ch 3, skip 3 stitches, sc to the end.

Row Three: Ch 1 and turn. Sc all stitches including the ch 3.

Tie off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

Using the yarn needle, sew the two ends together. Clip on your badge at the eyelet and enjoy!

* This project is more dependent on the finished length more than the gauge. Swatch and adjust your stitch count for your preferred length.

The pictured sample is made from Lily Sugar 'n Cream Solids cotton in red. The quarter for scale.



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
